

German Films Abroad 2024

Facts and Figures



GENERAL NOTES

- Basis of data: This evaluation of international cinema figures was based on data from the ComScore database. ComScore presents international box office turnovers and audience numbers as reported by the respective distributors. Films and their respective statistics that are not reported to ComScore cannot be included in the evaluation.
- Calculation of missing admissions figures: As some countries enter their box office turnovers but not their audience numbers, the latter have been calculated. The calculation of the number of admissions is based on the average ticket prices of the respective country published annually by the European Audiovisual Observatory. Data calculated in this way are marked (*).
- Definition of majority German films: The definition of majority German films was brought into line with the FFA definition in 2019. Thus, films are referred to whereby the largest share of financing is German. In the evaluations prior to 2019, films for which financing consisted of at least 50% German shares were referred to as majority German. For this reason, a comparison of box office and audience figures between the period up to and including 2018 and the period from 2019 onwards can only be made for all films with German participation (majority and minority). As a basis for the assessment, the funding shares are taken from the BAFA notification (if available).

OVERVIEW

- After an increase in 2023, German films abroad recorded a slight decline in 2024 compared to the previous year. However, the results remain higher than in 2022.
- In 2024, a total of 531 German titles (both majority and minority productions) were evaluated worldwide in 67 countries, of which 269 (51%) were major German productions. In comparison, in 2023 there were 524 German titles (majority and minority productions) in 66 countries, of which 257 (49%) were primarily German.
- Overall, German films (majority and minority productions) generated a revenue of 116 million euros outside of Germany in 2024, reaching over 15.8 million viewers. This marks a slight decline in both box office revenue (2023: 121 million euros) and visitor numbers (2023: 18.8 million) compared to the previous year.
- For comparison: According to the CNC, majority and minority French films were able to achieve a box office of 250 million euros with 38 million viewers abroad (as of January 2025).
- Among the most successful majority German films of the year were CUCKOO, THE TEACHER'S LOUNGE, as well as THE SEED OF SACRED FIG, BOY KILLS
 WORLD and CHANTAL IN FAIRYLAND. Together, they achieved a box office revenue of 22.9 million euros and attracted 2.8 million viewers to cinemas.
 Among the minority German productions, PERFECT DAYS with a revenue of 25.9 million euros and the animated THE MAGIC REINDEER: SAVING SANTA'S
 SLEIGH, which earned a total box office of 8.6 million euros in 35 countries, were particularly successful. Additionally, the majority Dutch film PANDA BEAR
 IN AFRICA earned 5.9 million euros with 984.000 viewers.
- 269 majority German titles generated a total box office revenue of 44.9 million euros and attracted nearly 5.9 million viewers outside of Germany. This represents over 37% of the total box office revenue generated by German films abroad.
- The European market emerged as one of the most successful markets for majority German films in 2024, generating nearly 30.1 million euros in revenue (67% of the total revenue). The North American market followed with almost 10.8 million euros in revenue (24% of the total), with the highest earnings in the USA (10.4 million euros). The market in Australia and Oceania also contributed to the result with over 1.2 million euros (2,75% of the total revenue).

- CUCKOO, THE TEACHER'S LOUNGE, THE SEED OF SACRED FIG, BOY KILLS WORLD and CHANTAL IN FAIRYLAND have successfully positioned themselves
 among the top 5 films of 2024. Together, these films generated a combined box office of over 22.9 million euros worldwide and attracted more than 2.8
 million viewers outside of Germany (individual results are listed in the table).
- The 10 most successful majority German productions of the year included four films from the main genre "drama".
- 13 majority German films were released in ten or more countries, including two films that were released in more than 20 countries.
- In 2024, 269 majority German titles generated a box office of over 44.9 million euros and reached 5.9 million viewers outside of Germany. This corresponds over 37% of the total box office generated by German films abroad. In 2023, the figures were close to 31.7 million euros with 4.7 million admissions worldwide, which made up 26% of the box office.

- Similar to 2023, 66,9% of the box office in 2024 was generated in a total of five countries. The European market once again played a particularly important role, as it generated almost 50% of the total revenue for majority German films, with 30.1 million euros in earnings. Out of a total of 5.8 million admissions, 3.9 million (67%) attended majority German films in European cinemas.
- In 2024, alongside the USA (21 titles with 10.4 million euros and 1.07 million viewers) and Austria (59 titles with 10.3 million euros and 1.05 million viewers), France (19 titles with 7.6 million euros and 1.05 million viewers), Italy (88 titles with over 2.8 million and 448.000 viewers) and Spain (84 titles with nearly 1.7 million euros and 278.000 viewers) were also among the leading markets, ahead of the Netherlands (10 titles with 1.4 million euros and 130.000 viewers).
- Sales of majority German films in Greece made the 7th place with nearly 1.06 million euros, ahead of the United Kingdom and Ireland (ranked 8th with 1.03 million euros), Russia (10th place with nearly 965.000 euros), and Croatia (ranked 20th place with 222.000 euros). Mainly animated films such as MAYA THE BEE 3: THE GOLDEN ORB and THE SUPER ELFKINS were showcased in Greece.
